UMOS HOUSE RULES FROM 1977

Being late will induce a fine – UMO Helsinki Jazz Orchestra's rules of conduct from year 1977 exhibit the spirit of shared responsibility.

UMOS house rules from 1977:

- 1. It is the responsibility of the organizers of the orchestra (2 ppl) to see to the necessary preparations before rehearsals and performances. It is the responsibility of the organizers to keep a record of lateness and absences
- 2. Each incident of lateness will induce a fine, the size of which is determined here later
- 3. The curator and assistants of the collection of sheet music are responsible for sheet music, and for delivering required materials to rehearsals and performances
- 4. Musicians are responsible for the safe-keeping of personal sheet music, and collecting it in folders. The responsible musician is liable to compensate for any missing sheet music
- 5. In cases of force majeure, each musician is responsible for finding a replacement, and will be liable for any costs incurred
- 6. The limit for lateness is 15 min.
- 7. The fine for lateness is 50 mk.
- 8. The fine for absence is 100 mk. Failing to show up without prior notice, and an acceptable reason, is considered absence.
- 9. Being absent for over an hour, with prior notice, requires finding a replacement.
- 10. Fines will be deducted from the musicians salary.
- 11. The fine for disrupting a performance or a rehearsal is 100 mk.
